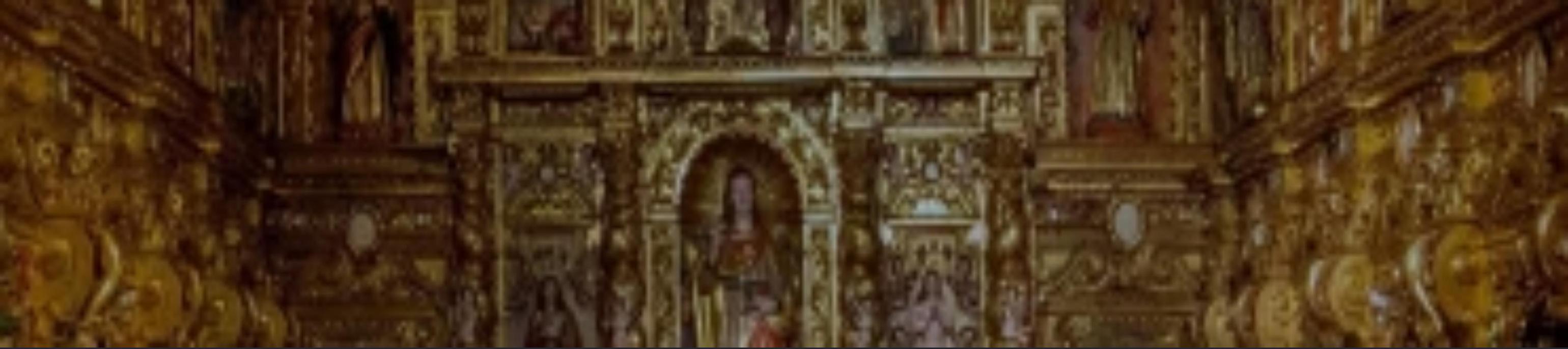

A frescoed building representing local art at its finest — a gem usually closed to the public.

The 365-Day Model

Smart access and immersive storytelling for a cultural experience available at all times.

Goal: Prove how a minor cultural asset can become an active attraction year-round through technology and professional management.



The "Porte Aperte – Open doors" Model: Technology & Know-how

An integrated solution combining accessibility, security, and immersive storytelling to enjoy of cultural heritage.



Smart Access

Instant booking via App with geofencing and automated smartphone entry. No keys, no fixed hours — total freedom for the visitor.



Immersive Narration

"Son et lumière" system with multilingual audio (3 languages) synchronised with directional lights illuminating specific fresco details.



Certified Security

24/7 HD camera monitoring with continuous environmental control of humidity and temperature for heritage conservation.

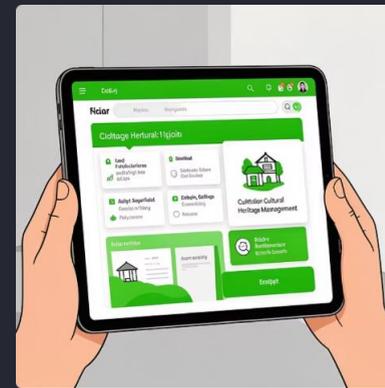
