ECONOMICAL IMPACT



- Direct pauments for the 2024 campaign \rightarrow 4,882 million euros to increase the remuneration of farms and contribute to their resilience.
- A fairer and more equitable CAP. Redistributive payment from which 10.7 million hectares have benefited in Spain in 2023, a figure similar to that of 2024 according to the applications submitted.
- 598,151 farmers and stockbreeders have submitted the single application for Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) aid for 2024 \rightarrow nearly 22.2 million hectares, an area that remains stable in recent years.

This is indicative of the maintenance of the economic and environmental activity carried out by the agricultural sector in Spain, as well as its increased professionalization.





SOCIAL IMPACT

- Generational renewal and equality. 220 million euros per year to generational renewal, double the budget of the previous period.
- This significant budget increase is reflected in the figures paid as of October 15, 2024: €98 M in supplementary payments to young people, compared to €46 M in the 2022 campaign.
- Gender focus. 15% increase in the supplementary payment to young people in the case of women.





ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

- Increase in the degree of acceptance of Ecoschemes with respect to 2023, both in terms of surface area and applicants → 19,200,567 hectares requested → acceptance degree at national level reaches 88%.
- 77.5% of holders who have submitted a Single Application have applied for some practice included in the Ecoschemes → Settlement of these practices on farms, as well as their adaptation and the effectiveness of the flexibility measures adopted, as the degree of penetration increases especially in those regions where the uptake was lower in the first year of application.
- High demand for organic farming intervention in many regions.
